

SUN COUNTRY QUILTERS GUILD QUILT SHOW - April 1 & 2, 2023
ENTRY INSTRUCTION SHEET Deadline to submit all forms: Feb. 27, 2023 for all quilts

Optional Professional Judging Available

- Judging will be by a professional quilt judge on Mar. 30 and will be open for viewing.
- Judging fee of \$10 is required only if you wish your quilt to be judged.
- Quilts that are not entered for judging, will not be charged an entry fee.
- No cash will be accepted by mail or returned by mail. Make checks payable to Sun Country Quilters Guild. Cash payments will only be accepted at guild meetings; written receipts for cash payments will be issued.
- All members are encouraged to enter quilts in the show, regardless of whether judging is selected. We will need to have at least 200 total entries for a successful show.
- Ribbons will be in place throughout the show for judged quilts.
- All quilts are eligible for selection as "Viewer's Choice", selected by show attendees and awarded on April 2nd.

All Entries – Guidelines and Procedures:

1. **Only SCQ Guild Members who have paid 2022 and 2023 membership fees by Feb. 27, 2023 may enter items in this show. We hope all members will submit at least one quilt. The quilt show takes a group effort to be successful and it is expected that all entrants will help with the many opportunities provided.**
2. Complete 1 entry form for EACH entry. Print all information legibly; turn in forms at any guild meeting by the deadline above or mail forms and payment to **MaryAnn Crain 10625 Bryne Ave. Los Molinos, CA 96055**
3. Entries must be quilted and finished, made of fabric, and in good condition (clean, free of odor and debris).
4. Items previously entered in a SCQ quilt show or unfinished items will not be accepted at the show.
5. All quilts larger than miniature size must have a 4-inch sleeve sewn along the top width of the back of the quilt. That top side will be considered the **width** of the quilt when filling out the entry form and the quilt will be hung from that side. Both top and bottom edges of the sleeve must be sewn down. Demonstrations for making sleeves, filling out forms, and other preparations will be given at guild meetings.
6. SCQ reserves the right to decline an entry based on the total number or size of items entered. On each entry form, fill out the number of entries that you want to enter. Then you must prioritize each entry on its entry form. You will be notified prior to the show if your entry is declined due to lack of exhibit space.
7. All exhibitors must sign insurance waiver at bottom of their entry form. In addition, it is responsibility of the exhibitor to seek and obtain any permission that may be required by the pattern designer to display the entry.
8. One 3" x 5" or larger color photo of each quilt must be submitted with entry form. The photo may be submitted by email to suncountryquilters@yahoo.com at the same time your entry forms are submitted. The photo or file sent by email must be labeled with your membership # and the name of the quilt that matches your entry form. A "work in progress" photo is acceptable if it shows the colors and pattern clearly. Photos will be taken at guild meetings upon request.
9. All quilted entries must be hand delivered to the Tehama District Fairgrounds Cafeteria Building on Wednesday, March 29, 2023, 2 pm – 5 pm.
10. You will need to complete 2 paper labels for each quilted entry delivered. 1 paper label must be sewn on or securely attached using 2 safety pins for each label. When facing the back of the quilt, place 1 label on the back lower right corner or pin 1 label on the inside of wearable item with 2 safety pins. The attached label will serve as identification. A separate label must be presented at check-in and will be verified to serve as your claim ticket. This verified label must be presented to the committee when you collect your items at the end of the show.
11. Entries must be picked up Sunday, April 2, between 4:00 pm and 6:00 pm at the Tehama District Fairgrounds, or as soon as take down has been completed after the show. An alternate may be designated to pick up your quilt with your verified receipt or "claim ticket" label.
12. For Judging, the Judge and Committee have the right to change categories, grouping of classes, or sizes to be judged together if it is deemed necessary. SCQ reserves the right to edit entry information for the display and/or program.

- ✓ Attached Artist's Statement page for each entry

- ✓ Check for \$10 - for each entry to be judged
- ✓ Signature and date on Insurance Waiver on each entry form

Size: Measure Width (side with sleeve) & Length; add Width plus Length. Multiply by 2 to equal Perimeter

- SMALL – Perimeter measures 0 to 215 inches (includes table toppers, runners, etc.)
- MEDIUM – Perimeter measures 216 to 299 inches
- LARGE – Perimeter measures 300 or more inches

Category Definitions: Choose only 1 category below, that best represents your quilted item.

- PIECED – Piecing predominates over applique or other technique either in amount or effect.
- PAPER PIECED- Pieced using paper templates with sewing done on pattern lines provided.
- APPLIQUÉ (Hand) } Appliqué predominates over piecing or other techniques in either amount or effect
- APPLIQUÉ (Machine) } techniques in either amount or effect
- WOOL APPLIQUÉ – Uses wool appliqued onto cotton or wool background.
- EMBROIDERY (Hand) } Embroidery predominates over piecing or other techniques in either amount or effect
- EMBROIDERY (Machine) } techniques in either amount or effect
- ART – Extends beyond traditional and innovating disciplines, using personal expression and originality in design, color, or technique
- MINIATURE – Maximum 24" on any side and maximum block size of 4"; representative of a full-size quilt, not just 1 small size block
- WEARABLE/OTHER - Fashionable, wearable garment or accessory item made with quilting techniques, includes bags, pillows, etc.
- MIXED TECHNIQUES – **2 or more** techniques, special effects, crazy quilts, cathedral windows, etc.
- KIT or BLOCK of the MONTH – Purchased kit or BOM with pattern and fabric supplied to you
