QUILT SHOW 2021 ENTRY INSTRUCTION SHEET

Optional Professional Judging Available

- Judging will be by a professional quilt judge on Nov. 11. Entire quilt may be judged, or you may choose to have the machine quilting judged, whether done by domestic or long arm machine.
- **Deadline to enter: August 23, 2021 for all quilts**
- Judging fee of \$10 is required for judged quilts, only. Limited to 60 quilts.
- Quilts that are not entered for judging, will not be charged an entry fee.
- No cash will be accepted by mail or returned by mail. Make checks payable to Sun Country Quilters Guild. Cash payments will only be accepted at guild meetings; written receipts for cash payments will be issued.
- All members are encouraged to enter quilts in the show, regardless of whether judging is selected. We will need to have at least 200 total entries for a successful show.
- Ribbons will be in place throughout the show for judged quilts.
- All quilts are eligible for selection as "Viewer's Choice", selected by show attendees and awarded on Nov. 14.

All Entries – Guidelines and Procedures:

1. Complete one entry form for EACH entry. Print all information legibly, turn in at any guild meeting by the deadline above or mail form and payment to **Barbara Johnson, 116 Santa Maria Ave., Gerber, CA 96035.**
2. Entries must be quilted and finished, made of fabric, and in good condition (clean, free of odor and debris).
3. Items previously entered in a SCQ quilt show or unfinished items will not be accepted at the show.
4. All quilts larger than miniature size must have a 4-inch sleeve sewn to the top of the back of the quilt. That top side will be considered the **width** of the quilt when filling out the entry form. Both top and bottom edges of the sleeve must be sewn down. Demonstrations for making sleeves, filling out forms, and other preparations will be given at guild meetings.
5. SCQ reserves the right to decline an entry based on the total number or size of items entered. On each entry form, fill out the number of entries that you want to enter. Then you must prioritize each entry on its entry form. You will be notified prior to the show if your entry is declined due to lack of exhibit space.
6. **Only SCQ Guild Members who have paid 2021 membership fees by May 24, 2021 may enter items.** Non-members may be solicited for entries only after the registration deadline, if needed to fill show. All entrants must participate in helping the show committee in some way.
7. All exhibitors must sign insurance waiver at bottom of their entry form. In addition, it is responsibility of the exhibitor to seek and obtain any permission that may be required by the pattern designer to display the entry.
8. One 4" x 6" or larger color photo of each quilt must be submitted with entry form. The photo may be submitted by email to barbara4q@att.net at the same time your entry forms are submitted. The photo or file sent by email must be labeled with your membership # and the name of the quilt that matches your entry form. A "work in progress" photo is acceptable if it shows the colors and pattern clearly. Photos may be taken at guild meetings upon request.
9. All entry items must be hand delivered to the Tehama District Fairgrounds Cafeteria Building on Wednesday, November 10, 2021, 2 pm – 5 pm
10. You will need to complete 2 paper labels for each entry delivered. 1 paper label must be sewn on or securely attached using 2 safety-pins for each label. When facing the back of the quilt, place the label on the back lower right corner. Pin label on the inside of wearables with 2 safety pins. This label will serve as identification. A separate label will serve as your receipt and must be presented at check-in and again to the committee when you collect items at the end of the show.
11. Entries must be picked up Sunday, Nov. 14, between 4:00 pm and 6:00 pm at the Tehama District Fairgrounds, or as soon as take down has been completed after the show. An alternate may be designated to pick up your quilt with your receipt.
12. For Judging, the Judge and Committee have the right to change categories, grouping of classes or sizes to be judged together if it is deemed necessary. SCQ reserves the right to edit entry information for the display and/or program.

 MEDIUM – Perimeter measures 216 to 299 inches

 LARGE – Perimeter measures 300 or more inches

Category Definitions: Choose only 1 category below, that best represents your quilted item.

 PIECED – Piecing predominates over applique or other technique either in amount or effect.

 APPLIQUÉ (Hand)

Appliqué predominates over piecing or other techniques in either amount or effect

 APPLIQUÉ (Machine)

 EMBROIDERY (Hand)

Embroidery predominates over piecing or other techniques in either amount or effect

 EMBROIDERY (Machine)

 ART – Extends beyond traditional and innovating disciplines, using personal expression and originality in design, color, or technique

 MINIATURE – Maximum 24" on any side and maximum block size of 4", Representative of a full-size quilt, not just 1 block

 WEARABLE- Fashionable, wearable garment or accessory made with quilting techniques

 MIXED MEDIA – **2 or more** techniques, special effects, crazy quilts, cathedral windows, etc.

 OTHER QUILTED ITEM (table toppers, runners, etc.)

For Judged Quilt Entries Only: You may also choose here to have a quilt's machine quilting judged.

 MACHINE QUILTING - Judging to be based on workmanship of the Machine Quilting by either Domestic or Long-Arm Machine
